(CLINICAL)**

Applications are invited for a research fellowship in the field of cell biology hosted by The South West Thames Institute for Renal Research in collaboration with King's College London Department of Renal Research, studying mechanisms of renal fibrosis. Successful applicants are likely to have completed Foundation Training at the time of application but will not yet have obtained a Certificate of Completion of Training; they will be expected to register for a PhD or MD (Res).

A clinical salary and research expenses will be provided and the successful candidate will carry out one to two sessions per week of clinical service as well as participating in the on-call service in the South West Thames Renal & Transplantation Unit, St Helier Hospital, hence eligibility to practice at registrar level within the UK is a prerequisite.
